Historical background

First introduced in 1947, the Willys pick-up was available in two-wheel and four-wheel drive as also in 1 ton and one and a half ton configurations. Sharing front-end styling with the Willys Wagon, the Willys pick-up was the workhorse of the Jeep brand. While this model was discontinued after the 1965 model year, Jeep would offer a pick until 1996 using names such as Gladiator, Scrambler and Comanche.
