Historical background

First introduced in 1974, the Jeep Cherokee is the two door version of the Jeep Wagoneer although a four door version was introduced in 1977. By offering both four door and two door models, the Jeep brand wanted to continue to expand the popular SUV market. While the Wagoneer and Cherokee shared the same basic body architecture, the grills, tail lights and body trim were different.
