Historical background

With its introduction in 1993, the Grand Cherokee set the standard for what was expected in terms of premium sport utility vehicle. Designed from the ground up with a focus on premiumness, the Grand Cherokee offered up-scale interior appointments without losing the off-road capability that had made the Jeep brand a legend. By joining the proven uni-body construction with the new multi-link, four-wheel coil set up of the Quadra Coil suspension, the Grand Cherokee set new standards in terms of both on and off-road handling. The new Grand Cherokee was also the first SUV to be equipped with a driver's side airbag and to offer three different four-wheel-drive systems. It also featured the only four-wheel-drive system with a high-range lock for highway speeds and a low-range gear for extreme off-road driving conditions: the Quadra-Trac.
